

CARRIER Step-by-Step PARS Clearance Process

FIRST Steps:

- Carriers must be in possession of a Non Bonded Carrier Code with Canada Customs.
- Carriers request A & A to print the PARS Labels.

What happens next?

- 1) CARRIER will pick up the load from the shipper, along with the paperwork.
- 2) CARRIER will put a PARS label on the paperwork, indicating:
 - *Port*
 - *Date*
 - *Time of crossing into Canada*
- 3) CARRIER will fax A & A Contract Customs Brokers Ltd. Pacific Highway office (Fax: 604.538.3994)
- 4) CARRIER can log into www.PARScheck.com (or call A & A at 1.800.663.4270) to find out if the shipment has been set up for release.
- 5) Upon arrival to the Primary Inspection Line (PIL) Booth, the CARRIER will present the Customs officer with his PARS paperwork.
- 6) Shipment will now be released or sent in for secondary inspection.
- 7) Once released, the CARRIER may proceed with delivery.
